In 2015, CHP Association will be holding one larger **annual meeting** instead of the past structure of having a policy forum and an annual conference. The conference will be on September 15th and 16th in Washington, DC. The theme, speakers, and agenda topics will be planned in the beginning of 2015. Contact us if you are interested in participating in the conference.



CHP Association will construct an **interactive map** of all the CHP facilities in the country. The map will allow for interactive searches within the map based on facility size, end-use, fuel source, and congressional district. This will be a resource for use by the CHPA Committees when working with private as well as public entities. We will send out an announcement once the map is up on the CHPA website.



The mission of the **Policy Committee** is to develop association viewpoints on key federal and state policy issues then implement a strategy to effectuate these priorities. The committee will have monthly calls on the second Tuesday of every month, with additional calls added when more frequent discussion is necessary. The Policy Committee's 2015 priorities will include: federal tax credits, federal appropriations for CHP, a national net meter standard, a national interconnection standard, a national energy efficiency resource standard, and state implementation of EPA power plant rules.



The CHP Association is also forming a new **End Users and Technical Committee** that will include members who are CHP end users. The goals of this committee will be to advance the interest of companies that use CHP and work with Policy Committee on policies relating to users.

The new **Membership Committee** will explore new areas for engagement in the CHP world including specific potential new members and more broadly, new membership categories, as the CHP Association continues to expand.

Dedicated to enhancing traditional alliances within the energy efficiency community as well as within the federal and state energy and environmental administrative and regulatory agencies, the **Education and Outreach Committee** will be a key force in aligning CHP Association positions with those of other groups.

The CHP Association **Executive Committee** functions as the lead group of companies and individuals responsible for managing the affairs of the association. The Executive Committee meets quarterly.



CHPA is planning a **CHP networking event** that will allow those interested in implementing a CHP project to gain connections with equipment manufacturers, project developers, financiers, and granting organizations. Stay tuned for updates.



CHP Association will host **monthly webinars** with partner organizations on topics relevant to both organizations. Partners will include Pew Charitable Trusts, ESCO Coalition, American Gas Association, US DOE, and US EPA among others. Topics discussed on the webinars will include tax policy, energy efficiency, EPA regulations in specific states, and state and local case studies. Updates on exact dates and topics for the upcoming webinars will be sent out shortly.
